

2022 TESA Artist-in-Residence Program Application Guideline

Founded in 2018, TESA Creative Center sets out from environmental concern and sustainable ecology, and inspires thoughts upon art, spaces, and the environment. Artist-in-Residence provides artists excellent places for art-making, living, research and exchange. Artists are also encouraged to contribute to the communities with art actions. Artist-in-Residence in TESA aims to have international exchange in-depth and at the same time, introduce Taiwan to the world through artists from all over the world.

Located at the naturally abundant Baisha Bay, TESA Creative Center consists of spacious places for art-making and detached living quarters . Artists are given the freedom to create their art projects around the untamed landscape. Artworks can be presented indoors or outdoors, so are exhibitions, forums, performances or seminars. A forklift, a stacker and an air compressor and all kinds of carving tools are available for artists. The saloon, the kitchen next to it and the wooden deck extending outwards are where artists can hang out.

A. Eligibility

1. To apply for the Artist-in-Residence Program, either Taiwanese or international applicants must be over twenty years of age .
2. Visual artist, or artist of other artistic fields who are interested in incorporating environmental arts into their creation.
3. No group registration is accepted.

C. Program description

Quota	4 artists
Grant	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Accommodation space: Personal accommodation space with independent bathroom equipment. 2. TESA Creative Center's indoor and outdoors space. 3. Working spaces and basic tools.
Obligation	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Artist Talks: Introduction of yourself, project, share the experience of the residency. 2. Final presentation or to hold 1 workshop for local communities or students.

D. Other Rights and Obligations

The Organizer will provide the following:

1. Artistic and technical consultations.
2. Information on local living and art activities
3. Assistance in arranging workshop in communities.
4. Space and technical assistance for final presentation.
5. Arrangement for presentations viewing and ideas exchange.

Artists-in-Residence are expected to be able to accomplish the following:

1. Be able to communicate in English or Mandarin.
2. Complete the 30 days on-site residency.
3. Prepare and come with information and basic tools for their creations and also personal living necessities.
4. All related videos, audio, and printed recording created during the residency are co-owned by the creator and the TESA Creative Center. Both parties can use them for non-profit research and promotion purposes. If there is profit involved, it is needed to be discussed by the two parties.
5. ARTIST retains copyrights to his/her own works.

Notes

1. No group registration is accepted.
2. The contents of the program are provided by the Organizer. If the artist-in- residence wishes to incorporate other recourses into the program, prior notice and approval from the Organizer is required.
3. All subsequent developments of projects created during residency such as the creations, interactions and international collaborations are welcome and encouraged.

Due to limited resources and quota, not all applicants can be accommodated. Those not selected are welcome to participate in other related projects in the future.
